## *Are you up to it?*

### Culinary Arts Training Program Requirements for Student Applicants

Applicants for the training program must be:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have reading and math skills of at least an 8<sup>th</sup> grade level
- Be available for class from 8:30am – 3:00 pm Monday through Friday and attend on time daily
- Be available for a few evening events, with advance notice
- Be curious, ready to learn and willing to do homework
- Be conscientious about studying in order to be prepared for written tests
- Be passionate about and have a strong desire to work in the food service industry
- Be able to speak, read, hear and comprehend English in a fast paced environment
- Be able to see well enough to read from a distance and to visually inspect the food
- Have the ability to lift up to 50 pounds and stand up to 8 hours per day
- Have the mobility to move within a small space without endangering themselves or others
- Have adequate manual dexterity and strength to perform general kitchen duties (cutting, chopping, pouring, carrying)
- Be clean and sober and willing to take random drug tests
- Not be a danger to self or others
- Be ready, willing and able to accept employment before or upon graduation from the program.

The program remains free of charge for income eligible applicants
