Seed Saving: Prepare for next growing season by saving your own vegetable seeds!

- Each vegetable has a different method of preserving seed; Wet or Dry.
- Choose the seed from the biggest and brightest vegetables.
- If saving bean seeds, store for either next season or winter cooking.
- Store seeds in a sealed container in a cool and dry location until the following season.
