

Adding to these challenges, a significant reduction in Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits has taken food resources away from as many as 785,000 low-income New Jersey residents.

Tom, Jeff, and Brian have generously turned that same light toward Fulfill's critical mission. We are truly humbled by their selfless and extraordinary commitment to helping end hunger across our Shore communities, and to letting those neighbors who need us most know that they are not alone.

THE ELEANOR LEVINE UNSUNG HERO AWARD

Eleanor Levine, equal partner with her husband Leo in the WindMill Restaurants, contentedly worked in the main office of the organization and received very little recognition for her many contributions to the businesses. That selfless attitude also extended into many activities and aspects of her life. She encouraged Leo to be the deliverer of gifts, the granter of loans and the front man for the businesses. She knitted blankets for babies she would never meet, crocheted and mailed hats to men and women in the armed services serving overseas, purchased and had Leo distribute blankets in Miami to homeless people, and signed many monthly checks to charities. She performed all of those activities, not only because they were the right things to do, but also to pass down to her children and grandchildren the lessons of humility and giving back. Her lesson was that we are all responsible for our communities, without the need for recognition or glory. To her family and to those lives she anonymously touched, she truly was an Unsung Hero.

Rena and David Levy, in honor of Rena's mother, Eleanor Levine, established the Eleanor Levine Unsung Hero Award to annually recognize Fulfill volunteers who, much like Eleanor, live their lives selflessly in the service of others. Tonight, the Unsung Hero awards are presented to Jane Holloway and Jim Alaimo.

Meet This Year's Usung Heroes



Jane Holloway, who retired from a 29-year teaching career, started volunteering with Fulfill in October 2018. At one of our evening Mix Mingle and Sort events with her husband, she fell in love with the energetic atmosphere of Fulfill and eventually landed in Chef Mary's kitchen, helping with meal prep. She went on to help distribute food at our mobile pantries and even worked the reception desk. When meal prep was moved to our B.E.A.T. Center in Toms

River, Jane took the initiative to volunteer in the Neptune garden. In 2022, when Fulfill began running mobile pantries after a long hiatus during Covid, Jane was the first one to offer her services regularly on the Windsor Crescent mobile in Jackson, and she hopes to expand to other mobiles nearby. Chef Mary notes that Jane is one of her hardest workers, staying after to wash dishes and do laundry, all unasked. Jane likes to stay busy in

her life outside of Fulfill as well -- she volunteers regularly at the NJ Sharing Network and at the Howell Senior Center, where she teaches crocheting. After all that, in her "spare time," Jane trains her dog Brodie to compete in shows. We are all so thankful that she chose Fulfill as one of her pathways.



Jim Alaimo began volunteering through his employer, FINRA, in 2019. Shocked by the staggering numbers of residents experiencing food insecurity in Monmouth and Ocean Counties, he began his independent journey with Fulfill in February 2020 after retiring. Jim found his first niche in the Sort Room, leading the charge to pack crisis boxes, keeping production moving quickly and smoothly with a leadership style hallmarked by his caring,

friendly, and open nature. When he began to work in the Fulfill garden program with Jess Sinkhorn, Jim first soaked up the necessary knowledge and then began to take on the role of team leader, a natural for him. He has been the impressive force behind a team that has helped our Giving and School Garden Networks by building 16 greenhouses, and constructing over 30 raised garden beds. He has also performed countless maintenance repairs in the garden, at some of Fulfill's food pantries, and even in our own Neptune facility. In just three years of service, Jim has put in over 1,400 hours for Fulfill. With his drive to excel, all while having fun in the process, there are no signs of him slowing down. We are grateful!

Opportunities include organizing food drives, packing and sorting donations, helping with office work and mailings, helping at mobile pantries and with our feeding program partners, and so much more.

Did you know that in 2022, we had 851 volunteers put in nearly 43,00 hours? With the Independent Sector valuing an hour of volunteer time at \$29.95, our volunteers have saved Fulfill \$1.2M!

This past year, Fulfill has:

- Served nearly 12M meals through our network of over 280 feeding partners, including food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, after-school programs, and more.
- Utilized its bilingual Resource Connections Team Specialists to assist clients with SNAP (also known as food stamps), health insurance and other benefits. In our last fiscal year, the team assisted in 1,500 SNAP applications and 837 Medicaid/NJ Family Care applications.
- Provided weekly backpack meals to 1,000 children at 29 schools during the school year.
- Graduated a total of 409 students through our free 13-week Culinary Skills Training Program since its inception in 2002.
- Distributed over 100,000 pounds of nutritious food, including fresh produce, to our hungry neighbors through our Mobile Pantry Program.
- Conducted surveys with our feeding network to better understand client needs, resulting in an organization-wide decision to purchase and increase protein, produce, and dairy products.
- Hosted a grand re-opening of The B.E.A.T Center, a community resource hub that helps Ocean County individuals access food, job training, and other services.
- Awarded 30 agency capacity grants to our feeding partners so they could more efficiently serve those who are food insecure. Grants approved included purchases for new freezers, refrigerators, shelving, equipment, and other much-needed upgrades to their operations.

MEET THE HONOREE: TOM CUNNINGHAM

The host of 'Springsteen On Sunday' on 107.1 The Boss (WWZY-FM) is in his 20th year of playing the music of Bruce Springsteen & The E Street Band and other Jersey Shore music scene stalwarts on Sunday mornings from 9 to 11. Cunningham began his radio career while a student at the University of Dayton, ending up at the Gem City's top-rated free form progressive rock station and eventually heading back east, spending 10 years at legendary heritage Top 40 station WPST in his hometown, Trenton. Cunningham then landed in Cherry Hill for three years working with industry icon Kal Rudman at the Friday Morning Quarterback. He has held executive positions in the promotion departments at Reprise Records, Jive Records, Universal Records and Vanguard Records. He is currently a format editor at the radio and record industry destination, All Access Music Group. Tom holds an annual all-request show that benefits Fulfill. In its 17th year, Tom takes song requests for a minimum donation of \$25 on the Sunday before Thanksgiving. His loyal listeners always grab the spots quickly with all funds benefitting Fulfill.

MEET THE HONOREE: JEFF KAZEE



"Throughout my career as a musician, I've been able to use my ability as a performer to help raise resources and awareness for many fine charities. Making sure our families and neighbors are fed and cared for seems to be the most basic need to be met. Over the years I've seen how Fulfill successfully navigates to better our community by delivering food, love, and respect to our neighbors in need. All done without fanfare or flash - Fulfill simply gets food to empty tables. Effective, from the heart, inclusive, and necessary. Although I'm a New York City resident, much of my career has been spent with New Jersey's finest musicians - and I owe a huge debt to this region that has given so much to me. 
A keyboardist and vocalist, probably best known for his longtime role as bandleader for Southside Johnny & the Asbury Jukes, for which he has (with Southside Johnny Lyon) written and produced the Asbury Jukes' critically-acclaimed albums Pills & Ammo and Soultime!, Kazee has recently written, performed, and produced his own solo album, titled Thanks For Checking In. A highly in-demand side musician and arranger for touring and recording, Kazee has worked across the country and internationally with Bon Jovi, Roger Waters, Dar Williams, Steve Kimock, The Blues Brothers Band, Gavin DeGraw, G.E. Smith Band and countless others. Early Elton Trio & The Poor Fools are two of Jeff's favorite bands that he co-founded. During the pandemic, Kazee created a "Live from the Living Room" series where he performed live on Facebook, ultimately raising over \$26,000 for Fulfill.

MEET THE HONOREE: BRIAN KIRK

Part musician, part singer, part comedian, Kirk is the lead singer of Brian Kirk & The Jirks, a popular Jersey Shore band for over 20 years. Kirk comes from a family of musicians; both his father and brother were band leaders. He is a self-taught musician who used to play in basement parties with a tip cup in front of him. Brian has come a long way since those days and is amazed that he gets to make a living playing music and celebrating some of the most joyous occasions of people's lives. He's equally amazed by the talent he surrounds himself with everyday. Brian and the band have played at Fulfill's Culinary Classic for many years. In recent years, Kirk chose Fulfill as the beneficiary for the 70th Birthday Tribute to The Boss at The Count Basie Center for the Arts and raised over \$23,000.
