What do we do?
Fulfill will offer eight in-person workshops during the spring and autumn semesters. Our Garden Educators will collaborate with teachers to provide students with hands-on experience in growing their own produce and making healthy food choices. By working alongside educators, we equip them with the skills and resources needed to successfully integrate a school garden curriculum into their classrooms, fostering a lifelong connection to fresh, nutritious food.



What will Fulfill provide?

- A garden bed, plants, soil, tools, lesson plans, materials, and six workshops each semester at no cost.
- Continued professional development in garden education for teachers.
